- Destruction of health care facilities in many governorates as a result for terrorism.
- Limited functional capacity of health facilities in relation to many factors of them (old fashion buildings ..etc).
- high prevalence of Non communicable disease risk factors e.g. (smoking, hypercholesteremia, DM and hyperglycemia, alcohol, over weight, people with 3 risk factors and more ...etc)
- Poor social determinants of health accompanied by collapsed infrastructures.
- High fertility and growth rate
- Limited role of private health sector.
