

THE IRAQI GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED THE NEED OF \$100 BILLION USD TO RECONSTRUCT CONFLICT-AFFECTED AREAS IN A TEN-YEAR TWO PHASE PLAN THAT WILL START IN 2018

Iraqi govt. Says \$100 billion needed for reconstruction in conflict-affected areas

- "Salman al-Jumaili, the Iraqi Minister of Planning said the reconstruction will cost the government of Iraq \$100 billion USD and will take ten years to rebuild areas damaged in the fight against the Islamic State (ISIS)
- Jumaili has reportedly adopted a twophase reconstruction plan, one of which is set to begin in 2018 and end in 2022. The second is set for the period between 2022 and 2028"

Iraq needs \$ 100 billion for reconstruction: spokesman

- "Iraqi ministry of planning on Saturday said it will approve a plan to reconstruct parts once fell under the control of ISIS terror group
- The ministry added the damage caused by the terror group in those parts will cost \$ 100 billion to be reversed"




